NOVA Flipped Studio "Successful Innovator"

WHAT IS NOVA?

NOVA is a 24-month project financed by ERASMUS+ programme; KA2 Strategic Partnerships for Adult Education. The project duration will be in the period 1.5.2021–30.4.2023.

WHO IS INVOLVED?

The project consortium is made up of 6 organizations from 5 European countries: Lithuania (SIF & BKC), Cyprus (CSI), Bulgaria (K&C), Romania (CPIP) and Italy (CESIE).

TARGET GROUP AND PARTICIPANTS

*Adult educators who could run the flipped studio «Successful Innovator»

*Adult learners willing to develop their sense of innovation

Learning, Teaching and Training Activity (LTTA) in Nicosia, Cyprus, 28, 29 & 30 September 2022

Nicosia, Cyprus' capital was the most recent stop of the promising NOVA journey. More than 20 partner staff members and professionals of the Cultural & Creative Sector had the unique opportunity to meet and pilot internally the training materials that the consortium has created so far. This pilot testing will give NOVA project the chance to review and improve aspects of these materials before testing them with 15 professionals in each country and deliver them to the CCS communities of partner countries and beyond. More specifically, the LTTA meeting included the following steps:

At first, participants who were not previously involved in the project to were introduced to the scope of the project the "flipped studio concept" the newly created NOVA training E-toolkit for adult educators and learners the NOVA Assessment E-tool for recognition of innovator's competences

The next phase included the following scheme:

Pre-assessment of knowledge regarding skills required in order to be innovative in the Cultural and Creative Sector Actual piloting of the e-platform "Successful Innovator" which included experiential videos of CCS innovators from the different partner countries. These videos were created following the NOOC format (Nano Open Online Courses) and included a post-watch quiz to test what users have understood.

After each piloting session – more than 20 NOOCs were tested – a feedback discussion followed which involved both the creators of the videos and the pilot-testers. The aim was for the creators to receive feedback and potentially integrate it in the finalisation of the different tools.

What is next?

Now, partners are preparing for the next transnational partner meeting which will take in Sofia, Bulgaria on 6 & 7 December 2022. Partners will discuss the finalization of the training tools which among others, includes voice-overs (doubling) in all partner languages so as to facilitate the education process in all partner countries (Lithuania, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Romania, Italy). Following the meeting, partners will return to their countries ready to train 15 professionals of the Cultural and Creative Sector and, after that, move towards the completion of the project with a Final Conference in Lithuania.
